TYPES OF DELIVERIES - UNIVERSAL



FEATURES OF THIS DELIVERY Delivered primarily by HSCL/SCP Some schools partnered with other schools or a community agency Open to all family members Self-referral HSCL/SCP referrals Larger group (8-15 parents) Mainly morning groups Parents may not need additional supports

TAILORED DELIVERIES

Parents who are members of the local Travelling Community

FEATURES OF THIS DELIVERY

- Pre-engagement work with families prior to PPCP starting (informal & formal)
- Previous relationship between parents and facilitators/ agencies delivering training
 - Small group (3-8 parents)
 - Programme adapted to meet specific needs of parents attending
 - Part of a structured delivery of support to the family
 - Additional support offered during the 8 weeks



POSITIVE OUTCOMES

- ✓ Significant improvements in children's behaviours, greater levels of parental satisfaction and reduction in parental stress levels
- ✓ Relationship building
- ✓ Parents increased involvement in school and community
- ✓ Up-skilling of facilitators and agencies
- Linking families with additional services post-PPCP
- ✓ PPCP embedded in school planning
